Housed in a 19th century building originally built as the Oxford College for Women, OCAC is the result of a collaborative community project to restore the structure of the building to protect the history and to create a center for visual and performing arts.

We invite you to participate in this endeavor and to consider submitting an exhibition proposal. Originality is of the highest priority and suitability for the space is also considered. The Oxford Community Arts Center's exhibition space consists of three areas: South Gallery (40-ish linear ft.); Hall (100-ish linear ft.), and the South Parlor (60-ish linear ft.).

Please note that the South Gallery is our only location for artwork with mature imagery. It is our policy to avoid any adult-themed imagery in the Hall and South Parlor. The Art Exhibitions Committee reserves the right to use discretion in the final installation.

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The Oxford Community Arts Center's exhibition space consists of three main areas:
